ORDINANCE NO. 051-15

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE CURRENT SEPTEMBER 2015 REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE NAPOLEON CODIFIED ORDINANCES

Section 5. That, if any other prior Ordinance or Resolution is found to be in conflict with this Ordinance, then the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail. Further, if any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or any part thereof.

Section 6. That, upon passage, this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
