ORDINANCE NO. 069-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO MAKE APPROPRIATION TRANSFERS FROM RESPECTIVE FUNDS. DEPARTMENTS AND CATEGORIES TO OTHER FUNDS, DEPARTMENTS AND CATEGORIES PURSUANT TO O.R.C. SECTION 5705.40 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2015 AS LISTED IN EXHIBIT "A" (FINAL); AND DECLARING AN **EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City appropriates funds by fund, department, and category of personal services and other; and,

WHEREAS, transfer from one appropriation item to another is necessary to provide appropriations for current expenses of the City; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO:

- That, pursuant to Section 5705.40 of the Ohio Revised Code, and this Section 1. Ordinance, the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to transfer from one appropriation item to another, in the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 2015, as listed in Exhibit "A" (Final), attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- Section 2. That, it is found and determined that all formal actions of this City Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings of this City Council, and that all deliberations of this City Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the City's Revised Code of General Ordinances.
- That, if any other prior Ordinance or Resolution is found to be in conflict with this Ordinance, then the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail. Further, if any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or any part thereof.
- That, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City and its inhabitants, and for the further reason that this legislation must be in effect at the earliest possible time to assure the prompt and efficient conduct of the municipal operations related to public peace. health or safety of the City; therefore, provided it receives the required number of votes for passage as emergency legislation, it shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage: otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
