A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING, CONTINGENT UPON THE PRESENTATION OF A PROPER PERFORMANCE BOND, THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS OVER TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00) FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAINING FACILITY FOR THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO FIRE DEPARTMENT LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO, AND AUTHORIZING THE SOLE SOURCING OF THE PROJECT TO W.R. MEYERS CO. INC., AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR SAID CONSRUCTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Napoleon, Ohio seeks to construct a new training facility for the City of Napoleon Fire Department; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Napoleon, Ohio has previously applied for and been granted funding for this project through the Local Government Safety Capital Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the original deadline for this project through said Grant was May 19, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Napoleon, Ohio did receive an extension to the above stated deadline until September 30, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, this project was previously advertised through the competitive bidding process twice, but was unsuccessful in receiving appropriate bids; and,

WHEREAS, W.R. Meyers Co. Inc., is familiar with the specialized skills and construction requirements needed to complete the project; and,

WHEREAS, attached as Exhibits "A" and "B" are statements from the City of Napoleon Fire Chief and Philip A. Whaley, P.E., demonstrating that W.R. Meyers Co. Inc., is familiar with the specialized skills and construction requirements needed to complete the project; and,

WHEREAS, the Council believes it is in the best interest of the City of Napoleon to eliminate the necessity for competitive bidding; Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO:

- Section 1. That, the City of Napoleon authorizes, contingent upon the presentation of a proper performance bond, the expenditure of funds in excess of \$25,000.00 from the 2017 Budget for the construction of a training facility for the City of Napoleon Fire Department located within the City of Napoleon.
- Section 2. That, Council finds it to be in the best interest of the City to eliminate the necessity for competitive bidding.
- Section 3. That, the City Manager is authorized, once said performance bond is presented, to enter into a contract with W.R. Meyers Co. Inc. to construct said structure.
- Section 4. That, it is found and determined that all formal actions of this City Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meetings of this City Council, and that all deliberations of this City Council and any of its

committees that resulted in such formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Codified Ordinances of Napoleon Ohio.

Section 5. That, if any other prior Ordinance or Resolution is found to be in conflict with this Resolution, then the provisions of this Resolution shall prevail. Further, if any portion of this Resolution is found to be invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution or any part thereof.

Section 6. That, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City and its inhabitants, and for the further reason that this legislation must be in effect at the earliest possible time so that the construction can be done as soon as possible to meet the deadline of the Grant extension, which affect the public peace, health or safety accessible to our citizens; therefore, provided it receives the required number of votes for passage as emergency legislation, it shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time permitted by law. Further, the Emergency Clause is necessary to begin the repair process in a timely manner, and for further reasons as stated in the Preamble hereof.

Subject: Request for sole source

I am requesting your approval to sole source the Napoleon Safety Services Training Facility (structure plan only) project. This project has been put out to bid twice and each time we have been unsuccessful in attracting the correct contractors to bid on the project. By correct I mean a contractor that has the skills for this specialized project, meet the timeline, and stay within the allowed budget.

We are under a tight timeline to complete this project and are already well into our only extension. This project is 100% funded by the Local Government Safety Capital Grant Program and the original deadline was May 19th 2017.

This project is a very specialized project with minimal qualified contractors to be able to perform all the aspects involved in the job. Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc designed this project and highly recommends W.R. Meyers Co. Inc. for this type of project. I have attached letters from our project coordinator and engineer from Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc.

At this point it would be very difficult to send this project back out to bid and expect that we would have a different result than we had the first two times. If we sent this project back out to bid again the bid process would complete in time, but the concern would be the structure being completed in time and all the paperwork processed for reimbursement within the timeframe outlined by our grant.

It is my recommendation to sole source the construction of the structure to W.R. Meyers Co. Inc. for the structural work only. This job is a very specialized job with a very tight budget and timeframe. W.R. Meyers Co. Inc. has the specialized skills to complete this project as well as meeting our timeframe and budget. W.R. Meyers Co. Inc. has quoted the entire structure at \$173,969.00 and stated he will be able to meet our September 30th 2017 deadline. W.R. Meyers Co. Inc. is fully bonded and this information can be provided at your request.

Joel,

As we discussed yesterday, I am sending a brief email to describe what we are seeing in the construction market.

I reached out to area construction companies asking that they bid on the Safety Services project. Four companies advised they might look at the project but are very busy with work under contract and may not be able to meet the budget or schedule. The construction industry is robust and many are working long hours to meet schedules.

We have recently bid 2 other public works projects and had very few bidders. Those that bid were well above the construction estimate. Small projects currently are not attractive and with a saturated market we find contractors taking less risk thus well exceeding cost estimates with inflated bids.

If you have the ability to sole-source the training facility and have a contractor that can meet both the budget and schedule I would recommend you move quickly in that direction and reduce your risk of losing the grant.
