**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE OHIO COMMISSION FOR THE UNITED STATES SEMIQUINCENTENNIAL**

**WHEREAS**, adoption of America250-OH's four pillars of EPIC will include education, preservation, innovation and celebration; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Council supports the Ohio Commission for the United States semiquincentennial; **Now Therefore**,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO:**

Section 1. That, the City of Napoleon, by and through this Resolution No. 008-24, proclaims its support of the of America250-OH and the mission to educate, preserve, innovate and celebrate every Ohioan in every County.

Section 2. That, the City of Napoleon further supports that a copy of this Resolution No. 008-24 be sent to the Henry County legislative delegation and America250-OH Commisison.

Section 3. That, it is found and determined that all formal actions of this City Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meetings of this City Council, and that all deliberations of this City Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Codified Ordinances of Napoleon Ohio.
