The Napoleon Police Department had investigated a complaint that took place at 330 S. Perry St. on August 16th, 2016 at approximately 2315 hrs. After further investigation it was discovered that the complaint was a robbery. It was learned that Jose Rodriguez, and an unknown female passenger had taken merchandise without paying for it. As the suspects were confronted about the theft, Jose Rodriguez, accelerated rapidly while leaving the store. The employee at Napoleon Party Mart had sustained minor injuries from when the vehicle had knocked the employee down and left the scene.

Jose Rodriguez, 42 years of age, address unknown, was charged with one count of Robbery, a Felony of the 2nd degree, and is currently being held at CCNO pending a court date on September-8th, 2016.
