

NEWS RELEASE 06-28-17

On June 28, 2017, the Multi Area Narcotics Task Force assisted with a traffic stop in Napoleon, OH. Following a K-9 alert, Approximately 1 pound of Marijuana was located in the vehicle. The operator of the vehicle Spencer Nelson, 20 Years of Age of Napoleon, OH, and the passenger Morgan Wyse, 18 Years of Age of Napoleon, OH. Both were charged with Possession of Drugs, a Felony of the 5th Degree. Following the traffic stop, the Multi-Area Narcotics Task Force executed a search warrant at the residence of both Spencer Nelson and Morgan Wyse, 906 Lumbard St, in the City of Napoleon. Additional drugs and drug paraphernalia were located at the residence. The case will be presented to the Henry County Prosecutor at the next Henry County Grand Jury for further charges. The Multi Area Narcotics Task Force was assisted by the Napoleon Police Department and Henry County Sheriff's Office.
