## *PRESS RELEASE*

At approximately 2133 hours on 08/14/2018 the Napoleon Police Department received a call reference an Aggravated Robbery at the Speedway 904 Scott St, in the City of Napoleon. During the investigation officers were given the description of the vehicle, and license plate number. At approximately 2310 hours officers located the vehicle on Devonshire Drive, in the City Of Napoleon and a Traffic Stop was conducted. During the stop the driver, Adam J. Payne, 26 year old male, from Napoleon was identified and taken into custody. Payne was charged with Aggravated Robbery(F1).

While being processed at the Napoleon Police Department, Payne was served with 2 outstanding Arrest Warrants, one for Aggravated Menacing and one for Assault. Payne was also charged with Escape(F3) and Vandalism-Government Entity(M-1), for an Attempted Escape and attempting to cause damage to a Police Vehicle.

Payne was transported to CCNO until his Initial Appearance in Napoleon Municipal Court. The Investigation by the Napoleon Police Department is ongoing.
