On Thursday August 23, 2018 at approximately 4:24 P.M. Officers of the Napoleon Police Department attempted to stop a vehicle on N. Perry St near Riverview Ave in the City of Napoleon as the driver had an active warrant for her arrest. The vehicle fled from the location heading south and continuing into the county, the Henry County Sheriff's Office was advised of the pursuit, Henry County Deputies were en route to assist. Officers pursued the vehicle turning down several county roads and continuing onto SR 281 heading into Defiance County. A deputy from the Defiance County Sheriff's Office assisted in the pursuit of the suspect vehicle until the vehicle left the roadway and began to drive through a corn field. Officers continued to pursue the vehicle until it stopped where the occupants were taken into custody.

The operator was identified as 37-year-old Christina Young of Napoleon, she was charged with Failure to comply with the order or signal of a Police Officer which is a Felony of the 3rd Degree and taken to CCNO.

The passenger was identified as 33-year-old Shane Ingle of Defiance, he was charged with Complicity to Failure to comply with the Order or signal of a Police Officer which is a Felony of the 3rd Degree and 2 counts of Tampering with Evidence which are both a Felony of the 3rd Degree and taken to CCNO.
