On 1-26-19 at approximately 2044 hours, the Napoleon Police Department received a call about a possible gas leak at 820 Sheffield Ave., which is the Pineview Apartments.

Napoleon Police and Fire/Rescue Department's, along with the Ohio Gas Company responded to the scene. Ohio Gas was able to close off the gas line; however, the building was evacuated as a precaution. This building has 12 apartments. Management responded as well.

Around midnight, the police department was updated that the gas and water lines were closed off, until further notice, to the entire building of 820 Sheffield Ave. and that the residents were with out heat and water. We were also informed that it was uncertain when the appropriate repairs could be made.

The Napoleon Police Department contacted the American Red Cross for assistance in re-locating the affected individuals for the duration of this incident. Approximately **6** families and **14 residents** were assisted by the American Red Cross.
