On January 2, 2020, the Multi Area Narcotics Task Force responded to 252 Patricia Ave in the City of Napoleon for an narcotic overdose complaint. The overdose victim was revived by Napoleon Fire and Rescue. During the course of the investigation, the source of the narcotic was located. On January 10, 2020, Kimber M Nadeau, 39 years of age of Napoleon, was arrested and charged with Trafficking in Drugs, a Felony of the 5<sup>th</sup> Degree and Corrupting Another with Drugs, a Felony of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. The case will be presented to the Henry County Prosecutor at the next Henry County Grand Jury for further charges. The Multi Area Narcotics Task Force was assisted by the Napoleon Police Department, Napoleon Fire and Rescue, and Henry County Prosecutor Gwen Howe-Gebbers.
