### LEVEL 1 SNOW EMERGENCY DECLARED FOR NAPOLEON

THE CITY OF NAPOLEON IS CURRENTLY UNDER A **LEVEL 1 SNOW EMERGENCY** AS OF THIS DATE **FEBRUARY 15, 2021 TIME 11:30AM.**

A Level 1 Snow Emergency is called when streets or roadways are hazardous due to blowing and drifting snow or freezing rain and extra caution is advisable when driving.

In anticipation of an increased amount of snow, the City of Napoleon will likely declare a Level 2 Snow Emergency later today. Below is a link to the City of Napoleon Snow Route Map, which is also attached to this Press Release. This map shows the snow plowing priority level for every road in Napoleon.

**When a Level 2 Snow Emergency is declared, NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARK ON THE PRIORITY 1 and PRIORITY 2 STREETS.** Vehicles may be towed if necessary, at the owner's expense. The Priority 1 and Priority 2 streets must be clear of vehicles in order to allow for snow plowing and to allow emergency services vehicles access to critical areas of the City. This is for safety purposes and everyone's cooperation is greatly appreciated.
