LEVEL 2 SNOW EMERGENCY DECLARED FOR NAPOLEON

THE CITY OF NAPOLEON WILL BE UNDER A **LEVEL 2** SNOW EMERGENCY AS OF THIS DATE **FEBRUARY 15, 2021** BY **6:00 PM**.

A Level 2 Snow Emergency is called When streets or roadways are hazardous due to blowing or drifting snow or freezing rain to the extent that it is advisable to travel only in case of necessity; or when certain streets or roads are closed due to weather conditions; or when there exists a necessity to clear certain parking areas defined by the City in the snow emergency routes or zones or in priority (1) and (2) snow removal areas.

Below is a link to the City of Napoleon Snow Route Map, which is also attached to this Press Release. This map shows the snow plowing priority level for every road in Napoleon.

When a Level 2 Snow Emergency is declared, <u>NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARK ON THE PRIORTIY 1 and PRIORITY 2 STREETS.</u> Vehicles may be towed if necessary, at the owner's expense. The Priority 1 and Priority 2 streets must be clear of vehicles in order to allow for snow plowing and to allow emergency services vehicles access to critical areas of the City. This is for safety purposes and everyone's cooperation is greatly appreciated.
