



Approximately 69% of the calls handled by the Officers in 2017 are considered Non-Criminal in nature. These calls can be anything from assisting other departments; such as the Fire/Rescue Department, the Henry County Sheriff and other agencies outside the City of Napoleon; to unlocks, beat and bike patrols, and civil assists. We also conduct school patrols, building checks and public relation talks. Any call that an alleged crime has not been reported, should be considered non-criminal. Traffic related calls would consist of traffic stops, parking patrol/violations, accidents and radar/traffic patrols.














NAPOLEON POLICE DEPARTMENT DETECTIVES BUREAU

SUMMARY REPORT 2017

The Detective Bureau currently consists of one Lieutenant as the direct supervisor two Detectives. The Detective Bureau investigated or assisted with investigation in over 300 cases. These numbers are not to represent a total call volume for the entire Police Dept. but are instead estimated call numbers for one division. The cases will be broken down into four major categories.

- Crimes Against Persons
- Property Crimes/Fraud
- Narcotics
- Special Assignments

Crimes against Persons:

The Detective Bureau was involved with in over seventy (70) complaints. Some examples of this would be Aggravated Assault, Kidnapping, Gross Sexual Imposition, Sexual Imposition, Pandering Sexually Oriented Material Involving a Minor, etc.... Out of the general sex complaints there were two (2) Rapes and twenty six (26) sex complaints investigated through the Bureau. The Detective assisted or directly investigated eight (8) Domestic Violence complaints, one (1) Menacing, eight (8) Felonious Assaults and one (1) Misdemeanor Assault. Twenty-four (24) Child Abuse/Endangerment complaints were examined and or investigated. Three (3) Abduction complaints were investigated as well.

Property Crimes/Fraud:

The Bureau was involved with over fifty-nine (59) complaints; Thirty-seven (37) Breaking and Entering's and Burglaries. The Bureau was involved with twenty-five (25) felony thefts and twelve (12) misdemeanor thefts. One (1) Criminal Damaging/Mischief complaint was investigated by the Division. Two (2) Receiving Stolen Property complaints were looked into. One (1) Fraud, ten Forgeries, and one (1) Auto theft were completed through the Bureau. Four (4) Robberies have also been investigated.





Narcotics:

The Bureau investigated or coordinated the investigation of over 74 Narcotic complaints. As mentioned before this number is not to reflect a total call number for the entire Police Department. The Detective Bureau, which includes a member of the Multi-Area Narcotics Task Force, has worked closely with FBI, DEA, ATF, and Henry County K9 Deputy. The Multi-Area Narcotics Agent has investigated 7 narcotic overdose incidents and assisted with 2 others in 2017, in which 1 was fatal. The Multi-Area Narcotics Agent has investigated 14 Narcotics Trafficking complaints and conducted twenty-two (22) searches within the City of Napoleon, either by warrant or consent. The Multi-Area Narcotics Agent has also assisted in 41 Narcotics complaints within the six county area that it covers.

Special Assignments:

Detectives conduct background checks of potential new hires for the Napoleon Fire Department and the Napoleon Police Department, as well.

The Bureau is subject to prepare and deliver documents to Municipal Court for each court date. It is also under obligation to prepare and review all charged felony offenses with the County Prosecutor for Grand Jury in the Henry County Common Pleas Court. The Detective conducts any follow up needed by the County Prosecutor or City Prosecutor for those charged felony offenses.

The Bureau has worked with the FBI and Secret Service on separate occasions in the investigation of Child Pornography and search of a Suspect's residence.

The Bureau is in charge of any evidence that is seized during an investigation whether it is by Officer or Detective. When testing of any type is needed, a Detective transports the evidence to the Bowling Green Bureau of Criminal Investigation and brings back anything that has been completed. Any polygraph examinations needed are conducted at the Bowling Green Bureau of Criminal Investigation and are scheduled and attended by the Detective. The Division works with Administration on the documentation and logging of all evidence and or found property.

This year the department handled approximately a 4% increase in traffic accidents. This resulted in a 60% increase in injuries.




