






Arrests & Services 2005




Traffic Arrests 2005





Not included in the above hours is the time that was spent maintaining certification in the BAC Datamaster. The NPD has 17 Officers certified in the use of the Datamaster.



The Napoleon Police Department currently consists of 23 Police Personnel and Officers and 8 Patrol Units. 4 Officers are certified for Bike Patrol. They logged approximately 120 hrs of patrol time this year.





Detective Bureau Summary for 2005

The Napoleon Police Dept. Detective Bureau has directly handled or been involved in the investigation and follow up over 200 cases both Felony and Misdemeanor.

The Bureau has also been responsible for the movement of over 100 pieces of evidence to and from the State crime lab located in Bowling Green Ohio.

Of this evidence there was over 27 pieces of evidence taken for drug testing; and over 22 pieces of evidence taken for DNA recovery and comparison.

The Bureau also conducted numerous covert operations involving surveillance and crime suppression. Also conducted were several undercover alcohol operations along with drug interdiction operations at the local schools including the use of canines from other jurisdictions.

Also the Bureau has been directly involved in or handled the processing of numerous crimes scenes which required the use of specialized evidence recovery techniques.

The Bureau also is responsible for all evidence seized and stored at the Napoleon Police Department. This involves the packaging standards, inventory and disposition of all property.
